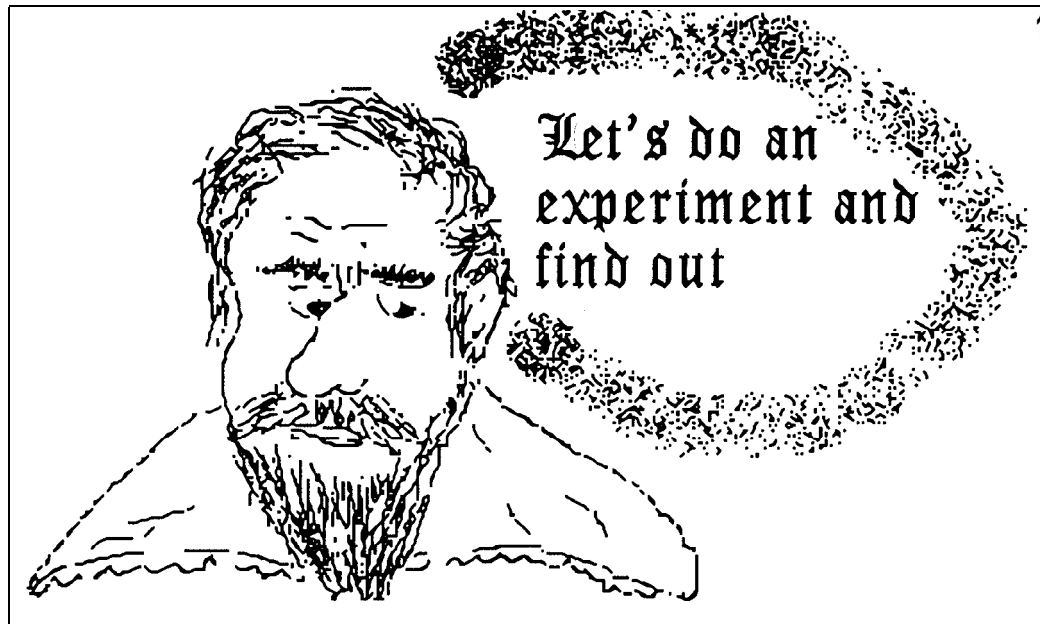


Homework 31f Ideas about gravity
